14	WHEREAS, OCM is experiencing a severe cash flow problem which ha							
15		resulted in an inability to timely pay its vendors; and						
16	WHEREAS,	the delinquencies in payments to OCM vendors has damaged						
17		the Nation's credit standing in the business community;

19	WHEREAS,	the lack of available cash has prevented OCM from making						
20	=	necessary repairs on its two concrete trucks and dump

30	WHEREAS,	T.L. Roof has presented a claim against OCM for \$86,483

Subject to Repayment and other Conditions) Page Two (2) WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Nation to initiate 1 discussions with T.L. Roof with respect to its alleged 2 damage claim to determine whether a settlement is 3 possible; and 4 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Nation to advance to 5 OCM, subject to repayment, the sum of \$117,217 to pay 6 certain delinquent invoices, enable OCM to purchase 7 concrete mix materials and repair specified trucks, as 8 outlined in the schedule of items and amounts attached 9 hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the 10 "Schedule"); and 11 WHEREAS, based on projected revenues and obligated funds for fiscal 12 year 1991, there are sufficient unobligated monies to 13 appropriate \$117,217 for these purposes. 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: 15 The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby 1. 16 appropriates the sum of \$117,217 to be expended solely 17 for the purposes prescribed in the Schedule (the 18 "Appropriated Amount"), and in accordance with the 19 following conditions: 20 All accounts relating to the operations of OCM (a) 21 shall be immediately transferred to and Nation's Accounting administered by the 22 Department in conjunction with any review and approval required by the Office of Chairman, with 23 appropriate changes made with respect authorized signatories on each account; and 24 The Appropriated Amount is a loan from the Nation (b) 25 to OCM which shall be repaid from OCM revenues not required to meet operating expenses; and 26 operations shall continue OCM's under (c) 27 supervision and direction of the Chairman of the Nation or his Designee pursuant to Council 28 Resolution No. 84-88, with the clarification that OCM bidding and contracting shall be subject to 29 the approval of the Chairman or his Designee; and 30 (d) An OCM Oversight Committee is hereby established comprised of Juanita Parvello, CFO; Leonard 31 Goeller, Director of Government Operations; and 32

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Ed Wroten, Director of the Credit and Finance Program, whose functions shall be to recommend to the Chairman's Designee (1) the payment of any OCM operational expenses, including payroll and the expenses and obligations listed in the Schedule, (2) the amount of OCM revenues required to cover ongoing operational expenses and the amount thereof available for repayment of the Appropriated Amount, (3) whether to authorize OCM to bid on or contract for prospective work in which OCM has expressed interest, and (4) within 60 days following the effective date of this resolution, whether or under what conditions OCM should be continued as a tribal entity.

- hereby authorized and directed to initiate discussions with the T.L. Roof, Chuck Westenburg and other appropriate persons involved in the School construction project, with respect to the claim asserted by T.L. Roof against OCM.
- 3. The Chairman's Designee and Attorney General shall present to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council at its next session, a recommendation concerning whether, or to what extent and on what terms, they propose a settlement of the T.L. Roof claim.
- 4. Nothing in this resolution shall be construed as an express or implied waiver of the Nation's immunity from suit, and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council reserves the right to assert such immunity in the future.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of October, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,261.5 for; -0- against; 462.5 not voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
