

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Proceed in Closed Session to Address Water Issues)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 394-90

1 WHEREAS, on October 30, 1990 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
2 met to address various water issues including an update
3 on the Water Recharge Feasibility study and the presen-
4 tation of proposed water consultants; and

5 WHEREAS, the Attorney General recommended that this meeting be
6 conducted in closed session because legal strategies and
7 options concerning water issues would be discussed as well
8 as their impacts on the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

9 WHEREAS, a recommendation was made to excuse the prospective
10 consultants from the session until called upon to give
11 their presentations.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
13 Council does hereby proceed into closed session to address
14 the water issues scheduled for this day's agenda.

15 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that attendance to this meeting be limited
16 to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Nation and
17 District Officials, allottees, and when appropriate, the
18 consultants.

19 The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the
20 30th day of October, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
21 present with a vote of 1,543.5 for; 127.0 against; 53.5 not voting;
22 -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
