WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has enacted Legislation,
Resolution #359-89, based on findings that "key components
of the BIA school system and the Tohono O'odham Nation's
oversight structure are not functioning properly.", and
has directed "the Legislative Council and the Chairman of
the Nation, in consultation with the affected groups and
individuals,....to analyze the underlying causes of the
problems and to take corrective action."; and

WHEREAS, the Legislation further provides that "the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Human Resources Development Committee, in consultation with other groups individuals, are authorized to carry out such activities as may be necessary to a)assess generally the BIA school system and tribal government's relation to it, and b) to make such recommendations for legislative or other action as may be appropriate.", and "that following completion of the assessments authorized here, the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Human Resources Development Committee shall, in consultation with other groups or individuals, prepare reports with reports recommendations for action. Such and recommendations shall be presented for consideration by the Legislative Council no later than March 1990."; and from the enactment of P.L. 100-297 and the implementation

the Legislative Council no later than March 1990."; and WHEREAS, recent positive developments in Indian Education resulting from the enactment of P.L. 100-297 and the implementation of education initiatives by the Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs requires that the Nation, through the Special Committee on Education, collectively explore the full potential benefits that the Nation may be entitled to; and

WHEREAS, through joint discussions of the Executive and Legislative Branches, it has been determined that the provisions of this Resolution and Resolution #359-89 can be best achieved through the establishment of a Special Committee on Education, with active participation of representatives of the Executive Office, Legislative Office, the Human Resources Development Committee, the Education Committee and the Education Department, and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is empowered under Article VI, Section 1.(b) to provide for and prescribe the duties of committees when it is in the best interest of the Nation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, in concert with the Nation's Executive Branch does hereby establish and empower a Special Committee on Education, to be composed of Representatives of the Executive Office, Legislative Office, the Human Resources Development Committee, the Education Committee and the Education Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Special Committee on Education is hereby authorized to carry out such activities as may be necessary to:

- (a) Assess generally the Education Programs and the school system serving the Nation and tribal government's relation to it.
- (b) Make such recommendations for legislative or other action as may be appropriate.
- (c) Research, review and recommend to the Nation's Legislative and Executive Branches regarding any and all matters pertaining to the administration and operation of Education Programs, and school systems serving the Nation.
- (d) Investigate the full potential benefits that the Nation may be entitled to under the provisions of P.L. 100-297.
