7		School, Tohono O'odham Nation, includes four portable
8		instructional units which are ten or more years old and
9		which must be replaced to adequately and safely
10		accommodate students; and
11	WHEREAS,	the present education facility, with portable units, will
12		soon fail to meet standards for school accreditation; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Papago Agency, Office of
14		Indian Education Programs, is submitting to the BIA,
15	2	Phoenix Area Office, Division of Facilities Repairs and
16		Improvement (FR & I) an application for the construction
17		of additional classrooms, kitchen expansion, office
18		expansion, and multi-purpose/media/library center; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation fully supports the efforts of
20		involved parties to provide adequate facilities for its
21		members attending Santa Rosa Ranch School.
22	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
23		Council that it hereby directs the Department of the
24	-	Interior, Office of Construction Management, BIA
25		Facilities Engineering, Branch of Facilities Repair and
26		Improvement to fund and take the required action to

30		appropriate staff do whatever is necessary to ensure the
