

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Santa Rosa Ranch School Facility Improvement and Repair)

RES. NO. 402-90

1 WHEREAS, the enrollment at the Santa Rosa Ranch School, Tohono
2 O'odham Nation, has increased considerably in recent years
3 (16 in 1981 to 127 in 1990) because of program expansions
4 which include special education programs and two
5 additional grades (7th & 8th grades); and

6 WHEREAS, the present education facility at the Santa Rosa Ranch
7 School, Tohono O'odham Nation, includes four portable
8 instructional units which are ten or more years old and
9 which must be replaced to adequately and safely
10 accommodate students; and

11 WHEREAS, the present education facility, with portable units, will
12 soon fail to meet standards for school accreditation; and

13 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Papago Agency, Office of
14 Indian Education Programs, is submitting to the BIA,
15 Phoenix Area Office, Division of Facilities Repairs and
16 Improvement (FR & I) an application for the construction
17 of additional classrooms, kitchen expansion, office
18 expansion, and multi-purpose/media/library center; and

19 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation fully supports the efforts of
20 involved parties to provide adequate facilities for its
21 members attending Santa Rosa Ranch School.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
23 Council that it hereby directs the Department of the
24 Interior, Office of Construction Management, BIA
25 Facilities Engineering, Branch of Facilities Repair and
26 Improvement to fund and take the required action to
27 provide the facilities requested in the application
28 submitted for Santa Rosa Ranch School expansion.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation's Officials and other
30 appropriate staff do whatever is necessary to ensure the
31 completion of the project.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th day of November, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,618.0 for; -0- against; 106.0 not voting; 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




