

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Fourth Year Funding for the Title VII
Bilingual Education Program)

RES. NO. 406-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Tohono O'odham Title VII Bilingual Education Program under
3 a three (3) year grant with the U.S. Department of
4 Education, Office of Bilingual Education and Minority
5 Languages Office; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is desirous to
7 continue to provide bilingual educational services to the
8 Tohono O'odham Nation; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Bilingual Education program greatly
10 enhances the regular curriculum at both high schools on
11 the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

12 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Education is soliciting for
13 continuation of grant application under the Transitional
14 Bilingual Education program; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Title VII Bilingual Education Program
16 has submitted a budget to continue funding for the fourth
17 year for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham
18 Legislative Council.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
20 Council that it does hereby support and request the U.S.
21 Department of Education, Office of Bilingual Education
22 and Minority Languages to consider continuation of funding
23 for year four.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
25 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
26 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
27 being conducted and no executed grant has been awarded by
28 the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Bilingual
29 Education and Minority Languages.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
31 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
32 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,

provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th day of November, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,618.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; 106.0 (03) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
