

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Sanitation Facility Deficiencies)

RES. NO. 410-90

WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, Office of Environmental Health
1 (OEH), conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities
2 Deficiencies, annually; and

3 WHEREAS, the OEH assessment does have an impact upon Congressional
4 appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and

5 WHEREAS, a Sanitation Deficiency Report was submitted for Council's
6 review; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council determines that the
8 top ten Sanitation Deficiencies as listed on the report
9 are priorities.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation has
11 determined that the following deficiencies are the ten
12 most critical and desirable, in descending order of
13 prioritization:



16 3. San Miguel
17 4. Big Fields
18 5. Santa Rosa Village
19 6. Vamori
20 7. Anegam
21 8. Chui Chu

24 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
on the 9th. day of November, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
25 was present with a vote of 1,240.5 for; 343.5 against; 140.0 not
voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
26 by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
27 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
28 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
29 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


