LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 41-90

1 WHEREAS, the Presiding Officer reviewed the agenda established for  
the February 21, 1990 Special Meeting; and

2 WHEREAS, this Special Meeting was requested to address budget  
3 modifications to grants and contracts programs; and

4 WHEREAS, the agenda also included "Authorization of SAWRSA Trust  
5 Funds for a San Xavier Recharge & Riparian Rehabilitation  
6 Project using C.A.P. Water," as item #10 to be presented  
7 by San Xavier District Chairman Austin Nunez; and

8 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Chairman requested that item #10  
9 be addressed first on this day's agenda; and

10 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee requested that consid-  
11 eration be given to their request regarding a luncheon to  
12 be provided for the Attorney General interviews which will  
13 be conducted on February 22 & 23, 1990.


14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative

O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
