

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 49-90)

RES. NO. 446-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did enact
2 Resolution No. 49-90, amending the 1989 Community
3 Development Block Grant; and

4 WHEREAS, DHUD-CDBG did not accept the amendment, based upon the
5 fact that it provides \$118,156.00 in administrative costs;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, DHUD-CDBG has limited the Nation's Administrative funding
8 for the 1989 grant to \$100,000.000; and

9 WHEREAS, negotiations with DHUD-CDBG has resulted in an agreement
10 for the additional \$18,156.00 to be utilized as follows:

11 UPPER COVERED WELLS

12 Construction/Supervisor Support \$ 5,377.86

13 SAN PEDRO

14 Construction/Supervisor Support 5,377.86

15 SIKOL HIMATKE

16 Cement Work 5,004.28
17 Landscaping 2,000.00
18 Lights and Poles 396.00

19 TOTAL \$18,156.00

20 WHEREAS, the already awarded 1990 Community Development Block Grant
21 providing funds for "Phase II" for Sikol Himatke is
22 dependent upon the Nation submitting a successful
23 amendment to the 1989 CDBG grant providing funds for Sikol
24 Himatke "Phase I;" and

25 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Nation and the District
26 and Community of Gu Achi and Sikol Himatke, respectively,
27 that this amendment to the amendment of the 1989 CDBG
28 grant be enacted.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
30 Council does hereby reiterate its support for the
31 submission of a proposal to electrify and improve the
32 water system of the community of Sikol Himatke, as
previously stated in Resolutions Nos. 63-89 and 49-90.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
2 does approve the amendment to the 1989 CDBG grant award
3 and to Resolution No. 49-90, amending the original grant,
4 including additions to the San Pedro project.


5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
6 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: The
7 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
8 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
9 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
10 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted
11 for further prior approval by this Council.

12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
13 on the 10th day of December, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
14 was present with a vote of 1,272.0 for; 229.0 against; 223.0 not
15 voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
16 by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


