

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY-91 Tohono O'Odham Youth Services)

RES. NO. 47-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Tohono O'Odham Youth Services Program under
3 an agreement with United Way of Tucson; and

4 WHEREAS, such services for the youth have been successful and
5 beneficial; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to enter into an
7 agreement for services during FY '91; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Youth Services/Prevention Education
9 has submitted a budget for review and approval by the
10 Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
12 Council that it does support and authorize the Tohono
13 O'Odham Nation to enter into an agreement with United Way
14 of Tucson for Prevention Education Services.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the Agreement will be
16 from July 01, 1990 through June 30, 1991.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
18 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
19 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
20 being conducted and no executed agreement has been
21 awarded by the United Way of Tucson Agency.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
23 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the
24 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
25 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement,
26 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
27 funding or funding levels of the agreement shall be
28 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
30 on the 21st. day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
31 was present with a vote of 1,423.5 for; -0- against; 300.5 not
32 voting; 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
