

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending 1989 Community Development Block Grant)

RES. NO. 49-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did solicit the participation  
2 of the eleven political districts of the Nation for  
3 priority needs for their respective districts; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did receive and approve the  
5 following proposals, for submission to the Department of  
6 Housing and Urban Development, Community Development  
7 Block Grant (CDBG) for funding consideration (pursuant  
8 to Res. No. 63-89)

- 9 1. Gu Achi District - Upper Covered Wells Community,  
10 Waste Disposal Facility
- 11 2. Gu Achi District - Electrification of Sikol Himatke
- 12 3. Sells District - Sewer System Upgrade
- 13 4. Schuk Toak District - San Pedro Community Well  
14 Construction; and

15 WHEREAS, subsequent to rating and ranking all proposals received,  
16 CDBG did award and fund proposals number one and four,  
17 Upper Covered Wells Community Waste Disposal and San  
18 Pedro Well Construction, respectively; and

19 WHEREAS, subsequent to the CDBG grant award, the United States  
20 Congress did appropriate emergency funds to support the  
21 critical need at San Pedro; and

22 WHEREAS, the \$580,000.00 provided by the United States Congress,  
23 through the Indian Health Service, Office of  
24 Environmental Health (OEH), will provide the bulk of  
25 funds necessary for the San Pedro Project; and

26 WHEREAS, the Office of Environmental Health (OEH) has determined  
27 it is desirous to provide the following additions to the  
28 San Pedro Community Project, considering the availability  
29 of funds:

- 30 1. 25,000 gallon water storage tank
- 31 2. A pump house, fence and controls
- 32 3. Replace existing 2-inch water line with 4-inch  
water line
4. Drill a second back-up well; and

1 WHEREAS, the amount of CDBG funds required for this project is  
2 reduced from \$835,650.00 to \$763,296.00 with a savings  
3 of \$72,354.00; and

4 WHEREAS, the Nation has the option of returning the \$72,354.00 in  
5 funds to CDBG or providing an amendment to the existing  
6 grant to utilize such funds; and

7 WHEREAS, the Nation, in Resolution No. 63-89, has already  
8 established two other projects as a priority need for  
9 consideration by CDBG, i.e.:

- 10 1. The electrification of Sikol Himatke
- 11 2. Sells Sewer System Upgrade; and

12 WHEREAS, the electrification of Sikol Himatke is the only one of  
13 the two projects that is feasible considering the  
14 \$72,354.00 in CDBG funds required for completion; and

15 WHEREAS, the 190 points received by the Sikol Himatke proposal is  
16 close enough to the 212 points required in order to be  
17 approved by CDBG, and there are sufficient additional  
18 points available and reasonably achievable.


19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
20 Council does reiterate its support for the submission of  
21 a proposal to electrify the community of Sikol Himatke  
22 to CDBG as previously stated in Resolution No. 63-89.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
24 does approve the proposed amendment to the 1989 CDBG  
25 Grant Award, including the additions to the San Pedro  
26 Project and the inclusion of the Sikol Himatke Project


27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
28 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the  
29 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are  
30 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant  
31 provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
32 funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted  
for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 21st day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






