14		CDBG did award and fund proposals number one and four,
15		Upper Covered Wells Community Waste Disposal and San

17	WHEREAS,	subsequent to the CDBG grant award, the United States
18		Congress did appropriate emergency funds to support the
19		critical need at San Pedro; and
20	WHEREAS,	the \$580,000.00 provided by the United States Congress,
21		through the Indian Health Service, Office of
22		Environmental Health (OEH), will provide the bulk of
23		funds necessary for the San Pedro Project; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Office of Environmental Health (OEH) has determined
25		it is desirous to provide the following additions to the
26		San Pedro Community Project, considering the availability
27		of funds:
28		1. 25,000 gallon water storage tank
29		2. A pump house, fence and controls
30		3. Replace existing 2-inch water line with 4-inch

NO. 49-90 (Amending 1989 Community Development Block Grant) Page Two (2) the amount of CDBG funds required for this project is WHEREAS, 1 reduced from \$835,650.00 to \$763,296.00 with a savings 2 of \$72,354.00; and 3 the Nation has the option of returning the \$72,354.00 in WHEREAS, 4 funds to CDBG or providing an amendment to the existing 5 grant to utilize such funds; and 6 the Nation, in Resolution No. 63-89, has already WHEREAS, 7 established two other projects as a priority need for 8 consideration by CDBG, i.e.: 9 1. The electrification of Sikol Himatke 10 2. Sells Sewer System Upgrade; and 11 the electrification of Sikol Himatke is the only one of WHEREAS, 12 the two projects that is feasible considering the 13 \$72,354.00 in CDBG funds required for completion; and 14 WHEREAS, the 190 points received by the Sikol Himatke proposal is 15 close enough to the 212 points required in order to be 16 approved by CDBG, and there are sufficient additional 17 points available and reasonably achievable. 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative 19 Council does reiterate its support for the submission of 20 a proposal to electrify the community of Sikol Himatke 21 to CDBG as previously stated in Resolution No. 63-89. 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council 23 does approve the proposed amendment to the 1989 CDBG 24 Grant Award, including the additions to the San Pedro 25 Project and the inclusion of the Sikol Himatke Project 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council 27 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the 28 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are 29 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant 30 provided however, that any amendments affecting the 31 funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted 32 for further prior approval by this Council.
