

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Citizen Participation Certification)

RES. NO. 50-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted an application  
2 received grant award from the Department of Housing and  
3 Urban Development - Community Development Block Grant  
4 (CDBG), and in connection with such application and  
5 award resolved and made certain assurances.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
7 Council that prior to the submission of its application,  
8 and amendments to the actual grant award, the governing  
9 body of the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided tribal  
10 citizens through their Council Representatives,  
11 especially those living in areas where activities are  
12 proposed or ongoing, with adequate information  
13 concerning the amount of funds available for proposed  
14 community development and housing activities, the range  
15 of activities that may be assisted, and other important  
16 program requirements and solicited their views and  
17 participation.


18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traditional Tribal means of citizen  
19 involvement were followed through District Council  
20 meetings and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
21 meetings, and opportunity was given to articulate needs,  
22 express preferences about proposed community development  
23 and housing activities, assist in the selection of  
24 district priorities, and otherwise participate in the  
25 development of the application.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no part of this paragraph shall be  
27 construed to restrict the responsibility and authority  
28 of the applicant for development of the application, or  
29 amendments thereto, and the execution of its Community  
30 Development Block Grant Program. Accordingly, the  
31 citizen participation requirements of this paragraph do  
32


1 not include concurrence by any person or group involved  
2 in citizen participation in making final determinations  
3 concerning the findings and contents of the application.  
4 The sole responsibility and authority to make such final  
5 determinations rest exclusively with the Tohono O'Odham  
6 Legislative Council.

8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council  
9 on the 21st day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a  
10 quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against;  
11 -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in  
12 the Council by Section 1 (c)(2)(d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the  
13 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
14 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
15 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
16 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
17 Stat. 984).


