

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Demographic Data)

RES. NO. 52-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation of Arizona has submitted an
2 application for a grant under the Community Development
3 Block Grant Program for Indian Tribes; and


4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation elects to submit demographic
5 data that are unpublished and not generally available in
6 order to meet the requirements of the application process.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
8 Council, in accordance with 24 CFR 571-300 (c) that:

- 9 1. Generally available, published data are substantially
10 inaccurate or incomplete.
- 11 2. The data provided have been collected systematically.
- 12 3. Data are, to the greatest extent feasible,
13 independently verifiable.
- 14 4. Data differentiates between reservation and BIA
15 service area populations

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
17 on the 21st day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
18 was present with a vote of 1,368.0 for; 356.0 against; -0- not
19 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 Section 1(c)(2) & (d)(2) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
21 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
22 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
23 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
24 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


