

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Citizen Participation Certification)

RES. NO. 53-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted an application
2 for a grant to fund certain eligible Indian Community
3 Development Block Grant Program activities and in
4 connection with such application resolved and made
5 certain assurances.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
7 Council that prior to the submission of its application,
8 the governing body of the Tohono O'odham Nation has
9 provided tribal citizens through their Council Repre-
10 sentatives, especially those living in areas where
11 activities are proposed or ongoing, with adequate
12 information concerning the amount of funds available for
13 proposed community development and housing activities,
14 the range of activities that may be assisted, and other
15 important program requirements and solicited their views
16 and participation.


17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traditional Tribal means of citizen
18 involvement were followed through District Council
19 meetings and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
20 meetings, and opportunity was given to articulate needs,
21 express preferences about proposed community development
22 and housing activities, assist in the selection of
23 district priorities, and otherwise participate in the
24 development of the application.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any comments or views expressed by
26 Tribal Members were considered and have modified the
27 application accordingly.


28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the modified application has been
29 made available to Tribal Members for review and comment.

3 quorum was present with a vote of 1,597.0 for; -0- against;
4 127.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in
5 the Council by Section 1 (c)(2)(d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the
6 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
7 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
8 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
9 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
10 Stat. 984).





23 submittal.


