

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorization of a 3% COLA for 1991)

RES. NO. 55-90

1 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has discussed the Cost
of Living Allowance for all employees of the Nation; and

2 WHEREAS, the Committee has recommended to the Council that the wage
3 and salary levels of all employees of the Nation be
4 increased by three percent (3%) for the fiscal year
5 beginning October 01, 1990; and

6 WHEREAS, the process for renewal of grants and contract appli-
7 cations for FY '91 has started for programs on funding
8 year cycles different from the Nation's fiscal year; and

9 WHEREAS, approval of the wage and salary increase at this time will
10 simplify the budget process for all contracts and grants
11 for FY '91.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
13 Council hereby approves the wage and salary level increase
14 in the amount of three percent (3%) for all employees,
15 elected and appointed officials of the Nation for fiscal
16 year 1991. This increase shall become effective on
17 October 01, 1990.


18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
19 on the 21st day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
20 was present with a vote of 1,433.5 for; 106.0 against; 184.5 not
21 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
22 Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
