

13 above indicated.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant from the No District
15 category is hereby tabled.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and other appropriate
17 officers of the Tohono O'Odham Nation reduce this final
18 determination in writing regarding each of the foregoing
19 applications for enrollment in accordance with Section 3
20 (c) of Article III of the Enrollment Ordinance; give notice
21 of this Council's determination in accordance with Section
22 4 of Article III of the Enrollment Ordinance; and place the
23 names of each applicant upon the membership roll of the
24 Tohono O'Odham Nation in accordance with Article V of the
25 Enrollment Ordinance.

26 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council
27 on the 5th day of March, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
28 present with a vote of 1,537.5 for; -0- against; 186.5 not voting;
29 and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
30 Section 1 of Article II and of Section 1 (h) of Article VI of the
31 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
32 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986 and approved by the Acting
 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
 6, 1986 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
 Stat. 984).
