

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting Higher Education Services Appropriations Request)

RES. NO. 68-90

1 WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services now provides educational
2 opportunities, counseling and financial assistance to
3 eligible members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and

4 WHEREAS, a major Tohono O'Odham Nation priority is to provide
5 quality academic education to increase the number of
6 Tohono O'Odham professionals; and

7 WHEREAS, the number of applications has steadily increased while
8 at the same time the annual budget has decreased.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
10 Council that it does hereby urgently request that
11 Congress increase its appropriations for the Higher
12 Education Services in the amount of \$264,427.00 for the
13 Tohono O'Odham Nation and that the appropriate officers
14 of the Nation are hereby authorized and directed to bring
15 this request to the appropriate members and committees
16 of Congress.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
18 on the 5th day of March, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
19 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
20 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
21 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
22 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
23 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
24 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
25 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
