

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Appropriations Request for the Water Resources Inventory Study)

RES. NO. 71-90

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did hear a request by the Water  
2 Resources Department Acting Director and Water Management  
3 Committee Chairperson for the need to seek additional  
4 funding for the Water Resources Inventory Study; and

5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is aware that current funding is  
6 not adequate to complete a comprehensive study of the  
7 Nation's water resources in accordance with the Nation's  
8 638 Contract for the Study; and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is aware that appropriations  
10 requests approved by the United States Congress generally  
11 takes two years to reach Programs through the Bureau of  
12 Indian Affairs; and

13 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Tohono O'Odham Nation to fulfill  
14 the conditions of the 638 contract for the Water  
15 Resources Inventory Study; and

16 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council agrees the information gathered  
17 by the Water Inventory Study is of inestimable importance  
18 to current and future generations of Tohono O'Odham in  
19 the management of their natural resources.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it  
21 hereby approves the Water Resources Department  
22 appropriations request and directs the Nation's  
23 Appropriations Committee traveling to Washington, D.C.  
24 to request \$7,068,772.00 with which the Water Resources  
25 Inventory Study can be completed.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
27 that it does hereby urgently request that Congress  
28 increase its appropriations for \$7,068,772.00 for the  
29 Tohono O'Odham Nation's Water Resources Department and  
30 that the appropriate officers of the Nation are hereby  
31 authorized and directed to bring this request to the  
32 appropriate members and committees of Congress.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th. day of March, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,610.0 for; -0- against; 114.0 not voting; 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
