NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it the Water Resources Department hereby approves appropriations request and directs the Nation's Appropriations Committee traveling to Washington, D.C. to request \$7,068,772.00 with which the Water Resources Inventory Study can be completed. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby urgently request that Congress increase its appropriations for \$7,068,772.00 for the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Water Resources Department and that the appropriate officers of the Nation are hereby authorized and directed to bring this request to the appropriate members and committees of Congress.
