

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Advocate Program)

RES. NO. 75-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is submitting proposals of
2 appropriation for federal assistance; and
3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently operating the
4 Advocate Program with tribal funds; and
5 WHEREAS, the Advocate Program has submitted its proposal for
6 review and approval; and
7 WHEREAS, on March 6, 1990 the proposal was presented to the Tohono
8 O'Odham Legislative Council by the Director.
9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
10 Council that it does hereby urgently request Congress to
11 appropriate funding for the Tohono O'Odham Nation's
12 Advocate Program and that the appropriate officers of the
13 Nation are hereby authorized and directed to bring this
14 request to the appropriate members and committees of
15 Congress.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
17 on the 6th day of March, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
18 present with a vote of 1,499.0 for; 165.5 against; 59.5 not voting;
19 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
20 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
22 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
23 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
