LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 78-90

1 WHEREAS, by Legislative Order No. 78-90, the Tohono O'odham
2 Legislative Council included Baboquivari District
3 Resolution No. 002-90 for discussion; and

4 WHEREAS, the resolution concerned an employee of a program under
5 the Executive Branch; and


6 WHEREAS, Article I, Section 1.F, SESSIONS, provides: "The Legis-
7 lative Council may vote to proceed into Closed Session
8 during which time only the Legislative Representatives,
9 its Officers, persons providing testimony or advice, and
10 other the Legislative Council may feel to be appropriate
11 shall be present."

12 WHEREAS, a request was made to proceed in closed session to discuss
13 Baboquivari District No. 002-90 with representatives of
14 the Executive Branch present.


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative

27 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
