RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (In the Matter of Indian Child Welfare Act Case re: Raymond S.) RES. NO. 79-90 WHEREAS, the United States Congress enacted the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978:, pursuant to finding "that there is no resource more vital to the continued existence and integrity of Indian Tribes than our children," and that an "alarmingly high percentage of Indian families are broken up by the removal, often unwarranted, of our children"; and WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the enormous 8 importance of maintaining individual and tribal family 9 relationships, and is desirous of maintaining the intent of integrity of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978; and WHEREAS, Section 1915(c) of the Indian Child Welfare Act provides 12 that a preference for the placement of Indian children 13 shall be in accordance with their tribe's stipulated order of preference; and 15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Children's Code (Chapter II, Section 16 31) outline's the Nation's placement preference; and WHEREAS, Raymond S. is an enrolled member of the Nation; and 18 WHEREAS, it appears to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that 19 there exists substantial issues related to proceedings 20 and/or actions of the Superior Court of the State of California in the County of Sacramento; and 22 WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Social Service has considered the best 23 interests of Raymond S. and the best interests of the 24 Nation; and 25 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Social Service has recommended: 26 That the Nation intervene in the proceedings in California in order to determine the alleged Indian 27 ancestry of the prospective adoptive parents to insure that Sacramento County's Plan complies with the Tohono 28 O'odham Children's Code or alternatively; 29 In the event that it does not, that Raymond be placed with a Tohono O'odham family or a Native American 30 family within the jurisdiction of the Sacramento County Court; or 31 That in the event that adoptive parents of Native 32 American descent cannot be found, to request that Raymond's case be transferred to the Tohono O'odham Courts so that he may be placed with a Tohono O'odham family; and

(Firm) is 1 employed pursuant to a general counsel contract dated 2 September 24, 1989 to represent the Nation and the Firm 3 cannot represent the Nation in California. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Tohono O'odham Legislative 4 5 Council that it hereby adopts the recommendations of 6 Tohono O'odham Social Service as herein stated. 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with the provisions of 8 paragraph 6 of the Firm's general counsel contract the 9 Legislative Council does hereby approve the selection and 10 employment, by the Firm, of legal counsel in California 11 to represent the Nation in these proceedings in 12 California. 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that whichever attorney is subcontracted 14 by the Firm is licensed to practice in the State of 15 California and is familiar with the Indian Child Welfare 16 Act, and that the subcontracted attorney is subject to 17 final review and approval by the Chairman of the Tohono 18 O'odham Nation. 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that legal costs not exceed \$15,000.00 20 filing fees, retainer, travel and inclusive 21 miscellaneous expenditures. 22BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative 23 Council does hereby authorize the initiation of legal proceedings by the Nation's legal counsel in cooperation 24 25 with Tohono O'odham Social Service. 26 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th day of March, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.664.5 for; -0- against; 59.5 not voting; 27 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(1),(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono 28 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 29 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 30 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 31 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 32 Edward D.
