

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Requesting Increased Federal Appropriations for Indian Housing)

RES. NO. 80-90

1 WHEREAS, the most recent survey conducted by the Bureau of Indian
2 Affairs of American Indian Housing reveals that 98,781
3 new or substantially rehabilitated houses were needed in
4 1989 in order to meet minimum federal housing standards,
5 while a similar survey conducted in 1970 revealed that
6 only 63,000 were needed; and

7 WHEREAS, the deterioration of Indian Housing is closely reflected
8 in the gradual erosion of federal appropriations therefor
9 from \$898 million in 1980, to \$148 million in 1988; and

10 WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Budget proposes to
11 completely eliminate funding for Indian Housing "New
12 Construction" in the Federal FY 1991 budget; and

13 WHEREAS, such action would have a drastic and irreversible effect
14 on an already critical and deteriorating situation.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
16 Council that it does hereby urgently request that
17 Congress reverse the trend since 1980 of allowing the
18 erosion of support and appropriations for Indian Housing,
19 and increase federal appropriations so as to reach a
20 level of 500,000,000 (6000 units) until Indian Housing
21 meets minimum federal housing standards.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby
23 request the support of Congress, and specifically of its
24 Arizona delegates, to increase appropriations for Indian
25 Housing to a level of \$500,000,000 (6,000 units) in the
26 Congressional Budget Resolution, Appropriations and
27 Authorizations recommendations and does hereby authorize
28 and direct the Appropriations Committee, the Chairman and
29 other appropriate officers of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
30 to seek support for and implementation of this
31 resolution.

32 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
on the 6th. day of March, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham

Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
