1	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation established a policy to require
2	the inclusion of indirect costs in all third party funded
3	agreements; and
4	WHEREAS, the policy provides for an exception and waiver of the
5	requirement by the Legislative Council if it is in the
6	best interest of the Nation to do so, that is when the
7	benefits to the Nation exceeds the need to collect the
8	revenues from the funding agency; and
9	WHEREAS, funding from the State of Arizona for the FY 1991
10	Tuberculosis Control Program is insufficient to cover both
11	direct and indirect cost needs of the program.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
13	Council finds that it is in the best interest of the
14	Nation to waive the indirect cost funding requirement for
15	the FY 1991 Tuberculosis Control Program.
16	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2nd. day of April, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
17	present with a vote of 1,314.5 for; 409.5 against; -0- not voting; 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
18	by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
19	1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
20	16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
