

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY'91 Tuberculosis Control Program)

RES. NO. 95-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated a Tuberculosis
2 Control Program to help prevent the spread of the disease
3 through community education, prevention, early detection,
4 comprehensive regimens and careful follow up for
5 individuals; and,

6 WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Tohono O'odham
7 Tuberculosis Control Program has been provided in part
8 through supplemental funding sources; and,

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Program office
10 desires to continue the services it provides to TB
11 susceptible patients; and,

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Program has
13 received funding from the Department of Health Services,
14 State of Arizona for its program.


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
16 Council that it hereby approves the proposal for funding
17 of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Program from
18 the Department of Health Services, State of Arizona and
19 that the duration of this contract will be from July 01,
20 1990 through June 30, 1991 unless extended by mutual
21 agreement of both contracting parties.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
23 that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
24 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
25 being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded
26 by the Department of Health Services, State of Arizona.


27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
28 that the Tohono O'odham Nations's Officials, to wit: the
29 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
30 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
31 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
32 funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2nd day of April, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




