

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Elderly Program Title VI Budget)

RES. NO. 97-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a
2 program for the elderly members of the Nation; and
3 WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been
4 possible in part by Article VI of the Older American's Act
5 of 1965 as amended; and
6 WHEREAS, the Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding by
7 submitting a proposal to the Office of Human Development
8 Services, Administration on Aging; and
9 WHEREAS, the Elderly proposal will benefit elder members of the
10 Tohono O'odham Nation by providing for their nutritional
11 and social support services.
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
13 Council that it hereby approves the proposal for continued
14 funding of the Elderly Program to provide services to
15 eligible members of the Tohono O'odham Nation.
16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence
17 on April 01, 1990 and end on March 31, 1992.
18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
19 that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
20 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
21 being conducted and no executed grant has been awarded by
22 the Office of Human Development Services, Administration
23 on Aging.
24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
25 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: The
26 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
27 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
28 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
29 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted
30 for further prior approval by this Council.
31 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
32 on the 2nd day of April, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
present with a vote of 1,431.0 for; -0- against; 293.0 not voting;
03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham

1 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
2 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
3 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
4 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


