3 O'Odham Nation, and that their applications are approved,  
4 as herein above indicated.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and other appropriate  
6 officers of the Tohono O'Odham Nation reduce this final  
7 determination in writing regarding each of the foregoing  
8 applications for enrollment in accordance with Section 3  
9 (c) of Article III of the Enrollment Ordinance; give  
10 notice of this Council's determination in accordance with  
11 Section 4 of Article III of the Enrollment Ordinance; and  
12 place the names of each applicant upon the membership roll  
13 of the Tohono O'Odham Nation in accordance with Article  
14 V of the Enrollment Ordinance.

15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council  
16 on the 7th day of January 7, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum  
17 was present with a vote of 1,487.0 for; -0- against; 237.0 not  
18 voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
19 Council by Section 1 of Article II and of Section 1 (h) of Article  
20 VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986 and approved by the  
Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
March 6, 1986 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
(48 Stat. 984).


