The Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, in 9 consultation with the Water Resources Committee and the Attorney General, is hereby authorized to 10 commence negotiations with the BIA to secure \$250,000. for technical experts and \$100,000. for 11 attorney services in connection with the Chuichu water claims. 12 2.
