15 Committees; and

16 WHEREAS, Save the Children raises funds for community based  
17 development projects through sponsorship, private and  
18 corporate contributions, and selected government grants.

20 Council hereby supports the philosophy of Save the  
21 Children Federation.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
23 hereby supports and approves of the establishment of Save  
24 the Children Federation (SCF) within the boundaries of the  
25 Tohono O'Odham Indian Nation.


26 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham


