WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has received and evaluated six proposals and cost quotes from insurance brokers and companies to provide comprehensive insurance coverage for the Nation in the areas of property and contents, general liability, public officials errors and omissions, police professional liability and received and evaluated three proposals and cost quotes for Workmen's Compensation insurance; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Branch through a committee review of these proposals, (attached as Exhibit A is a list of the membership of the review committee) recommends the following contracts consistent with the proposals and quotes be approved and executed to secure insurance:
