

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(San Xavier Rehabilitation - Contract No. 8-CS-30-04830
Budget Modification Nos. 15, 16, 17, 18, & 19)

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the San
3 Xavier Rehabilitation Contract under P. L. 93-638 with the
4 Bureau of Reclamation; and

5 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of
6 the contract shall be submitted for review and approval
7 by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation wishes to continue its efforts
9 towards the design of the San Xavier Cooperative Farm and
10 the implementation of SAWRSA; and

11 WHEREAS, reports, plans and other deliverables are necessary from
12 contractors to the Tohono O'Odham Nation in order to
13 continue these efforts; and

14 WHEREAS, additional funds are required in order to pay for
15 outstanding invoices from contractors to the Tohono
16 O'Odham Nation, and additional funds are required in order
17 to pay for the completion of the design of the San Xavier
18 Cooperative Farm; and

19 WHEREAS, this amendment has been submitted by the Tohono O'Odham
20 Nation's Water Projects Office for consultant services for
21 the Pre-design (Modification Nos. 15, 16 and 17) and
22 Design (Modification Nos. 18 and 19) phases for review and
23 approval.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
25 Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of
26 Reclamation to modify Contract No. 8-CS-30-04830
27 consistent with Budget Modifications 15, 16, 17, 18 and
28 19 described above and attached hereto, with the Tohono

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O'Odham Nation under the P. L. 93-638 regulations and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budgets upon approval by the Bureau of Reclamation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10th. day of January, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,381.5 for; 223.0 against; 119.5 not voting; -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




