9 WHEREAS, by Legislative Order 91-001 the Legislative Council
10 (Council) adopted for their January General Session a
11 report from the O'odham In Mexico Program (OIMP); and

12 WHEREAS, documents submitted by the OIMP included a draft
13 Resolution entitled, "Special Oversight Committee for the
14 O'odham In Mexico Program", and a supporting Resolution
15 dated September 3, 1990, enacted by the Traditional
16 O'odham Leaders; and

17 WHEREAS, the presenters of the OIMP report made references to
18 these resolution but refused to read them for the
19 record; and

20 WHEREAS, in adopting the matter for discussion, it was the intent
21 of the Council that the activities of the OIMP be fully
22 disclosed for the record.

23 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, BY THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE
24 COUNCIL that the draft Resolution entitled, "Special
25 Oversight Committee for the O'odham In Mexico Program",
26 and a supporting Resolution dated September 3, 1990,
27 enacted by the Traditional O'odham Leaders be read for
28 the record.

The foregoing Legislative Order was presented by the Tohono O'odham
Council on the 15th. day of January, 1991 at a meeting at which
a quorum was present with a vote of 568.5 for; 796.5 against;
359.0 not voting; and 03 absent, failed to pass because it did
not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2
of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.


