

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Recess and Reconvene on January 17, 1991)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 91-030

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did meet on
3 January 15, 1991 for their General Session; and

4 WHEREAS, the agenda established for the day, consisting of five
5 items were reviewed and approved; and

6 WHEREAS, a lengthy discussion on item #1 (Resolution from the
7 Traditional O'Odham Leaders) left insufficient time for
8 the remainder of agenda items to be discussed; and

9 WHEREAS, a request was made to recess today's session and to
10 reconvene on January 17 1991 to complete the agenda
11 items.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
13 Council that it hereby recess the January 15, 1991
14 General Session and reconvene on Thursday, January 17,
15 1991 to continue the discussion on the agenda items:

16 #2 (Resolution Approving a Legal Services Consultant
17 Contract with Univeristy of Arizona Office of Indian
Programs,

18 #3 (Demanding that George S. Barnett Immediately Turn
Over Documents to the Attorney General),


19 #4 (Sif Oidak District Resolution Regarding Upcoming
20 O'Odham Tash) and

21 #5 (Budget Amendment for Administrative Provisions
22 regarding Purchase of Commodity Truck).

23 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the
24 15th. day of January, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
25 present with a vote of 1,385.5 for; 132.5 against; 206.0 not
26 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
27 by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
