

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving a Legal Services Consultant Contract with the
University of Arizona Office of Indian Programs)

2 WHEREAS, there is a need to enter into attorney contracts to
3 supplement the legal services available through the
4 Office of Attorney General in connection with repre-
5 sentation of the Tohono O'odham Nation concerning the
6 land and water claims of the Nation within the historic
7 Papagueria which relate to the O'odham and Hia-Ced
8 O'odham ancestral lands in both Mexico and the United
9 States; and

10 WHEREAS, on recommendation of the Attorney General, the Legis-
11 lative Council approved a budget for the Office of
12 Attorney General for fiscal year 1991 which included an
13 allocation of \$50,000 to fund an attorney contract for
14 these purposes and for grant development relative to such
15 purposes; and

16 WHEREAS, the approved budget contemplated a contract with certain
17 programs directed by Professor Robert Williams, namely
18 the University of Arizona Office Indian Program ("OIP");
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed a Legal Services
21 Consultant Contract with OIP, a copy of which attached
22 hereto, under which OIP would provide the services
23 mentioned above.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
25 Council hereby approves the Legal Services Consultant
26 Contract with the Office of Indian Programs, in the form
27 attached hereto; authorizes the Chairman's Designee and

Attorney General to negotiate such changes in the Contract, prior to execution, as may be required to secure University approval, provided that any such changes are consistent with the Constitution and laws of the Nation, do not modify the University parties or University attorneys now named in the Contract or the budget or a term of the Contract; and authorizes the execution of the Contract by the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation, or his Designee, and approval thereof by the Attorney General.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17th day of January, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,296.0 for; 273.0 against; 155.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




