(Proceed in Closed Session to Address Item #2)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 91-033

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's agenda for  
3 January 17, 1991 included a Resolution from the Attorney  
4 General, entitled: "Demanding that George S. Barnett  
5 Immediately Turn Over Documents to the Attorney General";  
6 and

7 WHEREAS, due to the sensitive nature of this issue the Attorney  
8 General recommended that this be addressed in closed  
9 session

10 WHEREAS, in accordance with Article I, Section 1.F of the  
11 Legislative Rules a motion was made to formally close the  
12 session to address this item.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
14 Council that it hereby proceed into closed session to  
15 address the Resolution from the Attorney General,  
16 entitled: "Demanding that George S. Barnett Immediately  
17 Turn Over Documents to the Attorney General.

18 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Traditional O'Odham Leaders, the  
19 Director of O'Odham in Mexico Office and the Chairman's  
20 Designee are hereby allowed to remain in the closed  
21 session.


22 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham

27 VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,  
28 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,  
and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
