WHEREAS, private attorneys have presented ceratin tort claims for damages against the Tohono O'odham Nation on behalf of their clients; and

WHEREAS, these claims, which are not a matter of public record, are identified in the memorandum of the Attorney General and attachments thereto which accompany this Resolution; and WHEREAS, the Nation's insurance carrier has conducted an investigation of the claims and has requested instructions from the Nation regarding the assertion of sovereign immunity; and WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council believes that it is in the Nation's best interests to assert sovereign

immunity with respect to the subject claims.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- the Attorney General to instruct the insurance carrier that the Tohono O'odham Nation asserts sovereign immunity concerning the foregoing claims or any future claims which arise out of the same subject matter.
- 2. The memorandum of the Attorney General and attachments thereto which accompany this Resolution are privileged and confidential, and shall be maintained as confidential documents by sealing them in an envelope and preventing disclosure thereof except upon prior written authorization of the Legislative Council or pursuant to a lawful order of a court of competent jurisdiction.
