7 the above named applicants are eligible for enrollment as
8 members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation under Section 1(a)
9 or (b) of Article II of the Constitution of the Tohono
10 O'Odham Nation, and that their applications are approved,
11 as herein above indicated.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and other appropriate
13 officers of the Tohono O'Odham Nation reduce this final
14 determination in writing regarding each of the foregoing
15 applications for enrollment in accordance with Section 3
16 (c) of Article III of the Enrollment Ordinance; give
17 notice of this Council's determination in accordance with
18 Section 4 of Article III of the Enrollment Ordinance; and
19 place the names of each applicant upon the membership roll
20 of the Tohono O'Odham Nation in accordance with Article
21 V of the Enrollment Ordinance.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council
23 on the 4th day of March, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
24 present with a vote of 1,660.5 for; -0- against; 63.5 not
25 voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
26 Council by Section 1 of Article II and of Section 1 (h) of Article
27 VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
28 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986 and approved by the
Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
March 6, 1986 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984).
