

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Health Department Staff Training In AIDS Counseling)

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
3 Community Health Services Program under FY 1991 P.L. 93-
4 638 contract with the Public Health, Indian Health
5 Services; and

6 WHEREAS, such tribal operation has been successful and beneficial
7 to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has been notified that funds are
9 available for AIDS Prevention Services to assist health
10 education and promotion; as well as disease prevention,
11 management and treatment to individuals, families, groups
12 and communities; and

13 WHEREAS, in order to meet the needs of our O'Odham with AIDS
14 education and prevention, the staff in the Health
15 Department need to be trained in counseling with People
16 With AIDS (PWA); and

17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has submitted a workplan and
18 budget to assist in staff counseling training and to
19 assist themselves in counseling with People With AIDS
20 (PWA); and

21 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
22 approved the workplan and budget for AIDS.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
24 Council that it hereby approves and requests Indian Health
25 Services to modify the Community Health Services Contract
26 No. 249-88-0011 to incorporate the attached workplan and
27 budget.

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
3 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the
4 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
5 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
6 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
7 funding or funding levels of this contract shall be
8 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
11 on the 4th. day of March, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
12 present with a vote of 1,667.0 for; -0- against; 57.0 not
13 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
14 by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
15 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
16 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
18 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




