## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Requesting increase in Federal Appropriations for Road Maintenance)

2	WHEREAS,	federal appropriations for road maintenance for the Tohono
3		O'Odham Nation are currently set at \$325,000 and result
4		in the attached operating budget for the Branch of Roads
5		of the Papago Agency which establishes that there are
6		approximately 325 miles of paved roads and 518 miles of
7		earth roads within the Nation served by a maintenance crew
8		of six persons and twelve pieces of equipment; and
9	WHEREAS,	because of funding constraints, the Branch of Roads is
10		currently able to maintain only 287 miles of 518 miles of
11		earth roads, and is unable to effectively maintain the
12		increasing number of paved roads which are deteriorating
13		almost as rapidly as new paving is added to existing earth
14		roads; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee of the Legislative Council
16		has determined that a crisis will result if existing roads
17		are permitted to deteriorate at current rates, and has
18		recommended that the Nation seek additional appropriations
19		for road maintenance; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Nation was successful in getting an additional appro-
21		priation of \$450,000 in FY '90 (these additional dollars
22		will be used to buy equipment). The Roads Maintenance
23		Base budget has been raised to \$325,000 a year but to
24		adequately maintain all the roads on the system, a yearly
25		budget of approximately \$2,000,000 is required; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Council concurs in the Committee's determination and
27		recommendation.
