

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Extension of Date for Recommendations of Water Resources
Committee on Recharge, 9B Farm and Other Alternatives)

2 WHEREAS, Legislative Council Resolution No. 395-90 extended to
3 March 1991 the recommendations of the Water Resources
4 Committee (the "Committee") regarding recharge, the 9B
5 Farm and other alternatives for use of the Central Arizona
6 Project water granted under the Southern Arizona Water
7 Rights Settlement Act; and

8 WHEREAS, the Committee has provided the Legislative Council with
9 a status report on each of the five tasks identified in
10 Council Resolution 206-90; and

11 WHEREAS, the feasibility study on the 9B Farm has been completed;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, the recharge feasibility study is near completion; and

14 WHEREAS, prior to making recommendations, the Committee proposes
15 (1) to provide copies of the studies to the Schuk Toak
16 District Council, San Xavier District Council, and
17 representatives of the San Xavier allottees for their
18 review and comment, and (2) to arrange for personal
19 presentations of the studies by the consultants to such
20 District Councils and representatives to enable the
21 consultants to fully explain their analyses and
22 conclusions, and respond to any questions or comments the
23 Councils or representatives may have; and

24 WHEREAS, the Committee believes that the information gathered
25 through the foregoing discussions is an essential part of
26 the data on which the Committee will base its
27 recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Committee has determined that an extension to April 30, 1991 will be sufficient to hold the meetings and formalize its recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that:

1. The date on which the Water Resources Committee shall present its recommendations on recharge, the 9B Farm and other alternatives is extended to April 30, 1991.
2. A Special Meeting of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is hereby set for April 30, 1991 for the purpose of receiving the recommendations of the Water Resources Committee.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 27th day of March, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,372.5 for; 110.0 against; 241.5 not voting; 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a),(c),(d)(2) & (i)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
