LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 91-110

2 WHEREAS, on April 2, 1991 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
3 proceeded with the agenda established for this day; and

4 WHEREAS, a request was made to address as items #3 and #4 the San
5 Lucy Farm Water Assessment and the State Tax on Dillon's
6 Tobacco Barn, respectively; and


7 WHEREAS, the request included to addressing both items in closed
8 session.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
10 Council that it hereby amends the agenda established for
11 April 2, 1991 to include, as item three, the San Lucy Farm
12 Water Assessment; and, as item four, discussion on the
13 State Tax on Dillon's Tobacco Barn.

14 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Legislature proceed in closed
15 session to discuss the preceeding items and that the
16 following persons be allowed to remain in this closed
17 session: the Nation's Attorney General; Representatives
18 from the Nation's Executive Office.


19 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the
20 2nd day of April, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
21 with a vote of 1,555.5 for; -0- against; 63.5 not voting; 106.0
22 (07) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
