WHEREAS, under Section 3(A) of the Statute, the Attorney General is authorized to represent the Tohono O'odham Nation and "such other entities as the Legislative Council shall authorize the Attorney General to advise and represent"; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Farming Authority (the "Farm Authority") was created pursuant to a Plan of Operation adopted by Council Resolution 72-79, as amended by Council Resolution 283-90; and

WHEREAS, the Farm Authority has entered into a General Counsel

Contract with the law firm of Strickland & Altaffer; and

WHEREAS, the legal interests of the Nation are primarily at issue in the Law Suit; and

WHEREAS, it is nonetheless advisable to join the Farm Authority as a party plaintiff for legal reasons; and

WHEREAS, it is advisable from both legal and financial perspectives that the Nation and the Farm Authority be represented in the Law Suit as parties plaintiff by the Attorney General; and
