

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1992 Community Education and Information Program)

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department has the  
3 primary responsibility to provide prevention and  
4 intervention services to families at risk for child abuse  
5 and neglect; and

6 WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security provides funds  
7 for the development and administration of child abuse and  
8 neglect prevention programs under specified terms and  
9 conditions; and

10 WHEREAS, Community Education and Information Program has been  
11 identified as one means of preventing child abuse and  
12 neglect; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Social Services Department has  
14 submitted an FY 1992 proposal for Community Education and  
15 Information Services for review and approval.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
17 Council that it does hereby approve the application of the  
18 Tohono O'Odham Social Service for a contract to focus on  
19 decreasing the incidence of child abuse and neglect  
20 through the provision of Community Education and  
21 Information Services reservation wide.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall  
23 commence on July 01, 1991 and end on June 30, 1992.


24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
25 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the  
26 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are  
27 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,


funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.


