BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on July 01, 1991 and end on June 30, 1992.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
