

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Judges Pro Tempore of the Tohono O'Odham Courts)

2 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is empowered by Article VIII,
3 Section 4 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
4 to appoint judges of the Tohono O'Odham Courts; and

5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did, by Ordinance No. 01-89,
6 Chapter II, authorize the appointment of judges pro
7 tempore to the Tohono O'Odham Courts upon the
8 recommendation of the Chief Judge; and

9 WHEREAS, the Chief Judge has submitted the names of attorneys
10 qualified pursuant to 2-103 of Ordinance No. 01-89 and
11 recommended their appointment as judges pro tempore of the
12 Tohono O'Odham Courts; and

13 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 107-89 appointed judges pro tempore for
14 terms of two and one years; and

15 WHEREAS, four judges pro tempore terms will expire effective May
16 1, 1991; and

17 WHEREAS, the Chief Judge has submitted the names of four attorneys
18 qualified to fill the current expired terms of judge pro
19 tempore; and

20 WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee has met with the Chief Judge and
21 discussed the qualifications of the individuals who are
22 being recommended for appointment as judges pro tempore;
23 and

24 WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee has determined that the persons
25 recommended are of good moral character, residents of the
26 State of Arizona for not less than five years, and are
27 admitted to the practice of law for not less than three



- Gary L. Thomas 2 year(s)
- Steve M. Titla 2 year(s)
- Robert A. Williams, Jr. 2 year(s)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointments of the foregoing named persons shall become effective on May 1, 1991

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th day of April, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 993.5 for; 344.5 against; 114.0 not voting; 272.0 [10] absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
