2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council convened on May 6,
3 1991 for their scheduled May General Session; and

4 WHEREAS, the Council were informed of the unfortunate passing of
5 Gu Vo District Legislative Representative Cross Antone on
6 May 5, 1991; and

7 WHEREAS, Representative Cross Antone was the most senior member of
8 the Legislature, having served continuously for the past
9 30 years; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council desires to convey
11 its utmost respect to the late Representative Antone and
12 his family and therefore, finds it necessary to postpone
13 its General Session to the week of May 13-17, 1991.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
15 Council that the scheduled May General Session is hereby
16 postponed and rescheduled to the week of May 13-17, 1991
17 in order that the Legislative Council may convey its
18 utmost respect and condolences to the late Representative
19 Cross Antone and his family.

20 The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the
21 6th day of May, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
22 with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; 05
23 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
24 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
25 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
26 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
27 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
28 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


