

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'Odham Head Start Program  
Quality Improvement Grant Funds)

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated a Head Start  
3 Program to provide and serve educational and pre-school  
4 learning experiences for children between ages of 3-5  
5 years; and

6 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services,  
7 Administration for Children, Youth and Families has  
8 announced supplemental funds for Quality Improvement,  
9 i.e., salary and fringe benefit increases and family  
10 literacy efforts; and

11 WHEREAS, the allotted funding amounts for quality improvement will  
12 become a permanent base to our funding level; and

13 WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has prepared a proposal for  
14 supplemental funds to be submitted to the Department of  
15 Health and Human Services.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
17 Council does hereby approve the Head Start Supplemental  
18 Grant Proposal.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
20 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the  
21 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are  
22 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant  
23 provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
24 funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted  
25 for further prior approval by this Council.


