L. 93-638 4 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs: and 5 WHEREAS, notification was received from the Bureau of Indian 6 Affairs advising the Tohono O'Odham Nation that funds are 7 available for obligation to reflect final funding for FY 8 1991; and 9 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of 10 the contract shall be submitted for review and approval 11 by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and 12 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval 13 by the Higher Education Program. 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative 15 Council does approve the amendment to the Higher Education 16 contract and authorize expenditures in accordance with the 17 attached budget. 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council 19 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: **20** Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are 21 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, 22 provided however, that any amendments affecting the 23 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be 24 submitted for further prior approval by this Council. 25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 13th. day of May, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was 26 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 27 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
