

1 LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
2 (Tabling resolution on continuing priorities for use of
3 SAWRSA Trust Fund Income)

4 LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 91-181

5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did meet on Thursday, May 16,
6 1991 for their general session; and

7 WHEREAS, today's agenda did include for discussion a resolution
8 continuing the priorities for use of SAWRSA Trust Fund
9 Income; and

10 WHEREAS, the Legislative Representatives deemed it necessary to
11 discuss with their respective districts items 2 and 3 of
12 the proposed resolution, which states:

- 13 2. Council representatives shall consult with their
14 respective Districts to secure recommendations
15 regarding Trust fund priorities.
- 16 3. The Districts' views shall be presented to the Water
17 Resources Committee for consideration and
18 recommendation to the Legislative Council regarding
19 any changes in the Trust Fund priorities.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
21 Council hereby tables the resolution "Continuing
22 priorities for use of SAWRSA Trust Fund Income" in order
23 to allow the District Councils to address the above
24 mentioned items.


25 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on

27 present with a vote of 1,319.0 for; -0- against; 405.0 not
28 voting; 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
